

## OUR REOPENING SAFETY PROTOCOL



There will be a maximum of 3 clients on site at any time



Body temperature checks upon arrival



Hand sanitiser will be available as you walk in the centre, and near the bathroom



All touch points in the waiting area, bathrooms, float rooms, and chill-out area including all door handles will be cleaned between clients.



Staff will have minimal contact with clients and from a safe distance of 1 metre plus wearing a face mask and gloves



Staff and clients will be required to wear face masks and disposable shoe coverings. We won't provide face masks however disposable shoe coverings will be available at the centre

Floatation tanks have features which provide water filtration and sanitation.



Water is filtered 3.5 times between float sessions for a period of 15 minutes, as well as overnight at set times to maintain hygiene levels.



A regulated dose of Chlorine is added to the water after the last session of the day to breakdown any microorganisms.



The inside and outside of the tanks will be disinfected after each client.



There will be a gap of 30 minutes between the float sessions to allow for a deep clean.



Each float tank is located in its own room, providing complete privacy and isolation
